

EXHIBITION GROUP

From November 25th to December 21st 2010

6° Senso Art Gallery opens on Tuesday 25th November from 7,00 pm a group exhibition concerning sixteen international artists: **Raffaello Ossola, Irene Petrafasa, Manovella, Giorgio Celiberti, Marco Tamburro, Ennio Calabria, Nag Arnoldi, Giulia Magnaguagno, Alexander Waltner, Sergio Lombardino, Renzo Vespignani, Manuela Sain, Alberto Sughì, Vanni Saltarelli, Luca Ciaccia, Antonio Tamburro.**

The exhibition is about a diverse group of works whether for theme or for technique: as a matter of fact there are exposed paintings, sculptures and photography. It ranges over the surrealistic nature by the visionary Raffaello Ossola to the clean sign that goes towards the abstract by Irene Petrafesa, the poised characters between dream and reality by Manovella.

Still going on, we find the highly tactile abstractionism on canvas and on sculpture by the great follower of Emilio Vedova, Giorgio Celiberti; the firm, rapid and essential stroke of the brush by Marco Tamburro; the coloured, elusive figures by Ennio Calabria and also the sculptured horses by Nag Arnoldi. The only one photographic work is the one by Giulia Magnaguagno who tells about woman through the photographic lens. To make the exhibition various we see the neo expressionist masks by Alexander Waltner and the past that lives in the present in Sergio Lombardino's painting. The realism of Renzo Vespignani contrasts the new reading in a pictorial way about pulp movies by Manuela Sain, the malincolic atmospheres by Alberto Sughì contrast the dynamism by Vanni Saltarelli; the quiet landscapes by Luca Ciaccia contrast the strong colouring by Antonio Tamburro.
